About

Tū Manawa Active Aotearoa provides funding for programmes or projects that activate and deliver sport, active recreation and play experiences for tamariki and rangatahi that are easily accessible and strive to create a lifelong love of being physically active. As this is an activation fund, priority will be given to programmes or projects that provide new experiences for those young people who are less active and more likely to be faced with inequitable opportunities to be physically active. We welcome applications for this fund for sport, active recreation and play projects from eligible organisations.

Examples of who we fund

- Hapū, Iwi, Marae, Māori organisations
- · Primary/Intermediate schools/Kura
- · Secondary schools/Wharekura
- Tertiary Education/Whare Wānanga
- Charitable Trusts
- Councils
- Incorporated Societies
- For-profit businesses/commercial organisations and social enterprises.

- Venue or equipment hire
- Support for volunteers or activity delivery staff
- Equipment (only where this is required as part of a project or delivery)
- Officials, where these are required for the delivery of the opportunity
- Costs associated with developing and promoting your activity.
- Examples of what we don't fund (Please refer to our webpage for more details)

- Costs that are not directly required for the provision of the activity that you are applying for (such as salaries or wages for existing staff, administrative overheads etc)
- Costs that are already funded by other sources
- Costs of retrospective projects or activities (those that have already been completed or held)
- Costs associated with professional athletes, professional sports teams, academies, or representative teams
- Capital costs (e.g., facility development and maintenance, playgrounds)
- Medals, prizes, giveaways, and spot prizes.


