

Public Notice of Release of Decisions on Submissions to Plan Changes 23 and 58 – Use of Wind Machines for Frost Protection

The Marlborough District Council publicly notified Plan Change 23 to the Marlborough Sounds Resource Management Plan and Plan Change 58 to the Wairau/Awatere Resource Management Plan on Thursday 24 September 2009:

In accordance the First Schedule to the Resource Management Act 1991, the Marlborough District Council hereby gives notice that it has now made decisions on the submissions and further submissions received in respect of this plan change or variation. The Plan has been amended to give effect to those decisions.

Every person who made a submission to Plan Changes 23 & 58 will receive a letter from the Council advising the Council's decision regarding their submission, the reasons for accepting or rejecting the decision sought, and any amendments to the Plan that may have arisen from the submission.

The Plan Changes, as amended through the Council's decisions on submissions, can be inspected without fee, at any of the following locations at any time that those facilities are open to the public:

- The Council's Office, Seymour Street, Blenheim
- The Marlborough Library, Arthur Street, Blenheim
- The Havelock, Seddon, Ward and Rai Valley Community Libraries
- The Council's Picton Office and the Picton Library, High Street, Picton
- Elma Turner Library, Halifax Street, Nelson
- Tasman District Library, Queen Street, Richmond
- The Wellington Public Library, Victoria Street, Wellington
- The Kaikoura Public Library, Kaikoura
- The Christchurch Public Library, Gloucester Street, Christchurch

On receiving notice of a decision on their submission or further submission, a submitter has further rights with regard to the Council's decision. Clause 14 of the First Schedule to the Resource Management Act 1991 provides the right to appeal the Council's decision to the Environment Court. Any appeal must be lodged within 30 working days of receipt of this notification of decision.
