Compliance with Consents U140294, U140295 and U140296: Condition #48

Thank you for your letter dated 25 August 2014 in relation to NZ King Salmon's consent to farm salmon at Waitata, Richmond and Ngamahau.

The information you have provided consists of advice that the odour management provisions of condition 48 has been complied with. This is with reference to the management provisions contained within section 5 of the Residential Amenity Plan dated 3 August 2014 (as required by condition 74a Ngamahau, and condition 75a Waitata and Richmond).

Compliance is not able to be determined at this point. This is because the condition states that odour management operational procedures have to be in place, and be implemented, prior to the first discharge of feed at each farm. Given that the farms have not yet been established at each site, the implementation of the procedures cannot be determined at this point.

It is also worth noting that this condition will continue for the life of the consent, and it is possible that complaints may be received in future which Council will need to investigate. Therefore, the implementation of the operational procedures will be ongoing so long as fish are farmed at the sites.

We look forward to your further advice once the farms are implemented that the operational procedures have been put in place.
