Dear Quentin and Peta,

Request for an aquaculture decision – The New Zealand King Salmon Company – Waitata Reach (U140294), Richmond Bay (U140295) & Ngamahau Bay (U140296).

The Ministry of Primary Industries has made a determination in relation to coastal permits U140294, U140295 and U140296. This means that the Ministry of Primary Industries is satisfied that the aquaculture activities authorised by the coastal permit will not have an undue adverse effect on recreational, customary or commercial fishing. No modifications are required to the proposed extension and no conditions have been tagged pursuant to section 186H(3) of the Fisheries Act 1996.

A notice of the Ministry of Primary Industries decision was published in the Gazette on 30 October 2014. A request for a judicial review of the aquaculture decision must be made within 30 days of the decision being published in the Gazette. The Director General's decision is not to be treated as made until any judicial review the decision is finally disposed of.

Accordingly, pursuant to section 116A(2)(b) of the Resource Management Act 1991, the Marlborough District Council hereby notifies the consent holder that coastal permits U140294, U140295 and U140296, as delineated within those permits, commences on 11 December 2014 subject to no judicial reviews being lodged.
