New Zealand King Salmon

1. Thank you for your e-mail of 15 April 2015 in respect of New Zealand King Salmon files.

2. Could you consider whether or not the following actions are appropriate:

a. *U130520 (Clay Point three-year discharge consent)*

NZ King Salmon proposes to not proceed with this application and accordingly asks you to close the file.

b. *U021247, U040217 and U040412 – Condition Reviews*

As you know these applications were borne out of an agreement entered into between NZ King Salmon and the Council that NZ King Salmon's existing consents would be reviewed. That agreement has been superseded by The Best Practice Guidelines work which has been undertaken in respect of benthic environment and operational matters.

All of these applications were lodged before the Best Practice work was undertaken. The Best Practice work contains its own timeframes. It would seem wrong to return to an application which is now out of date.

NZ King Salmon proposes not to continue with these applications and to follow the processes outlined in The Best Practice Guidelines.

3. Please advise whether the Council would be agreeable to that process being followed.
