Maida and Quentin, thank you for your letter dated 16 April 2015. In response U130520 will be closed asap. In terms of the condition reviews (U021247, U040217 and U040412) I don't believe it is appropriate to withdraw these applications as there will still need to be a condition mechanism to apply the best practice guidelines. The agreement we had (pre EPA decision) was that the existing consents would be amended to employ the monitoring and reporting requirements of the time. Post best practice documents, the condition requirements of the existing consents are significantly different (and in some cases more onerous) than the BPG. I recommend that the variations are held until the Te Pangu decision is made. Then the variations rewritten to be consistent with that decision.

Please advise whether your client would be agreeable to that process being followed.
