Compliance with Consent U140295: Conditions 22 and 23 – Structural Engineering Design

Thank you for your letter dated 8 April 2016, which we received on 27 April 2016, in relation to NZ King Salmon's consent to farm salmon at Richmond.

The information provided includes an anchor test pull-out loading and an accompanying report by a Chartered Professional Engineer. This meets condition 23.

The information provided also consisted of a peer review of the anchoring design in compliance with condition 22. Council advises that the information only partly complies with condition 22 at this time.

What was not supplied for this condition was evidence of the design being specified by a suitably qualified and experienced Chartered Professional Engineer to cater for the maximum wave loading, and maximum tidal range and currents. The condition also calls for the supervision of the installation of the anchoring system and certification from a Chartered Professional Engineer that it has been installed in accordance with the design report and plans. Please supply these at your earliest.
