Hi Reuben,

First a large disclaimer – this Biosecurity Management Plan is focussed primarily and understandably, on disease risk. The first emphasis for them is the protection of their stock. I do not have expertise in this area.

I guess what is needed is a yard stick from the regulator's point of view. The why they need to produce a detailed biosecurity management plan. From a NRM point of view, are we concerned about their practises due to a risk of disease transfer to wild fish stocks? Or more from the introduction and movement of invasive marine pests (fouling organisms) due to NZKS activities?

If its disease, then all I can really say, given my disclaimer – is their plan looks detailed and thorough. If you wish to get additional 'cover', you may wish to seek out someone with more expertise in disease risk. Steve Urlich may be able to assist re this?

If marine pests, the key area of awareness (spotting new organisms) is covered. However, the cleaning of equipment between sites/control zones is tended to focus on destroying pathogens. Be good to see a bit more in the protocols about ensuring vessels and equipment are free of biofouling before moving both between zones and to/from the key servicing hubs.
