<b>Subject</b>	Conditions 34 and 45 and 2016/2017 monitoring report		

I received a phone call from Mark Preece from NZKS after received emails (CM RN 18137687).

I confirmed to Mr. Preece that the report was in relation to the 2016/2017 annual monitoring report and not the 2017/2018 reports which had recently been received by Council.

Mr. Preece informed me that they had not discharged more nitrogen than the limit in condition 34 and that the way this is reported in the annual monitoring report needs to be amended.

I informed Mr. Preece that if Cawthron amend the report then I will re-assess this condition and amend my compliance report.

Mr. Preece and I then discussed condition 45.

Mr. Preece said that they could estimate the greywater discharge based on the amount of freshwater taken to the site. Mr. Preece informed me that that they would definitely not discharge more than the limit. Mr. Preece explained that they reuse some of the greywater which then becomes black water so they would discharge less greywater than they amount of freshwater they use.

I checked condition 45 and informed Mr. Preece that the way the greywater discharge has to be measured is not specified but they would need to make sure there method is an "appropriate system" (words in the consent condition) to determine the discharge amount.

Mr Preece asked if this needs to be reported in the Cawthron report.

I said that it didn't but they needed to provide Council with the volume each year and that this could be sent to [monitoring@marlborough.govt.nz](mailto:monitoring@marlborough.govt.nz) .
