## Approaching Expiry of Resource Consent for Your Marine Farm(s)

According to Council's records you are the holder of resource consent(s) for the following marine farm site(s) which are due to expire in whole or in part between now and 31 December 2024.

In relation to the expiry of resource consents, Section 124 the Resource Management Act 1991 (RMA) provides that:

- If an application for replacement consent is received prior to 6 months before the expiry date, the activity can continue as described in the original consent until a final decision on the new application is made.
- If an application for replacement consent is received between 3 - 6 months before the expiry date, Council has the discretion to determine whether the activity can continue, whilst awaiting a final decision on the application.
- If an application for replacement consent is received later than 3 months before the expiry date, the activity must cease upon the expiry of the existing consent.

At the present time there are approximately 325 marine farm sites in the Marlborough district which have resource consent(s) with an expiry date between now and 31 December 2024. A new resource consent(s) will be required for the continuation of each of those marine farm sites.

You are entitled to apply for a new resource consent at any time. You do not need to wait until just prior to the expiry of your existing consent(s). Any such application must be made in accordance with Section 88 and the Fourth Schedule of the RMA. An application fee of \$980.00 (base fee) is required at the time of applying for resource consent. Council's Charging Policy and Schedule of Fees are available from Council's offices or website <http://www.marlborough.govt.nz/Services/Resource-Consents/Fees.aspx>.
