## Natural habitat restoration for lowland South Marlborough

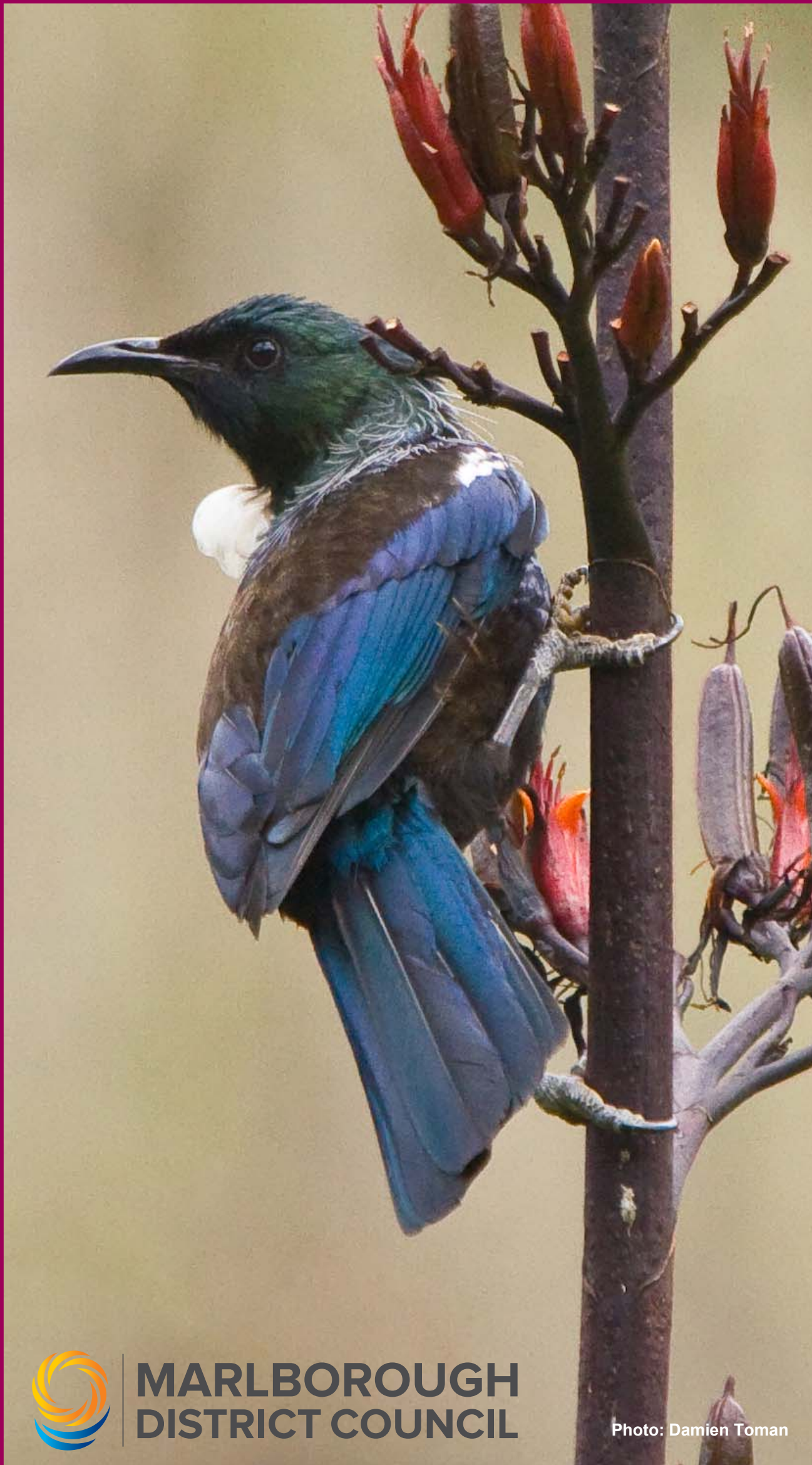
