

Waiving of Resource Consent Fees

Introduction

The waiving of Resource Consent Fees is an acknowledged way for Council to assist non profit organisations to reduce costs when developing facilities for community, social, recreation and cultural needs.

Policy

Council will waive resource consent fees for non profit organisations where the facility or activity is of community benefit and not for commercial gain.

The maximum level that can be claimed per application is set at \$1,500.

Eligible organisations can receive assistance once per annum.

Criteria

1. Applicants must be a not for profit organisation.
2. The facility or activity must be of community benefit and not commercial gain.
3. Individuals may be considered where the activity has significant environmental benefit.
4. Projects on private land can be considered from individuals where the activity has significant heritage value and evidence of this is verified.

How to Access

A request in writing to Council seeking a waiver of fees. This must include details of the organisation and the facility or activity the waiving of fees has been requested for.

Decision

Applications will be considered on a case by case basis by Council staff.

If it is not clear if the applicant or activity is eligible then the Manager, Support Services has delegated authority to make final decisions.
