

Sport NZ Rural Travel Fund Grants 2014/2015 Allocation

Sport NZ made funding of \$19,537.20 available for rural travel for young people aged between 5-19 years under specific criteria and eligibility conditions and with \$1,000 being brought forward from 2013/2014 there was a total of \$20,537.20 (rounded to \$20,540) to be allocated.
