

Sport NZ Rural Travel Fund Grants 2015-16 Allocation

Sport NZ had made funding of \$19,537.20 (rounded to \$19,550) available for rural travel for young people aged between 5-19 years under specific criteria and eligibility conditions to be allocated. All nine applications received were eligible for consideration. Requests totalled \$34,349.
