I understand that there is a need for boat trailer parking but I believe that another area should be developed for this purpose in the long term. Memorial Park is used by a variety of users throughout the year. When the park is used as a car park it becomes unsafe for the regular users (people running their dogs or children/families playing). Even when parking is provided in Memorial Park there are still trailers and cars filling the side streets.

The decision I seek from the Council is (where amendments are sought, provide details of what changes you would like to see):

Memorial park is bordered by a small stream along Hampden Street, this stream is home to a variety of fish and birdlife. There has been much publicity around the presence of a white heron using this stream over the last four months and it is also a regular hunting ground for kingfisher and other birds. The stream is also a potential breeding site for inanga, who lay their eggs in the riparian vegetation on riverbanks. Regular maintenance of the park sees the riparian vegetation weed whacked and removed. If the extension of the car park moves forward I believe that the walkway that is proposed should be designed to include riparian planting that extends along the whole length of the stream in Memorial Park. This will reduce the need to weed whack and improve the habitat for native fish and birdlife. It will also provide a safe space for those people that are walking their dogs or enjoying family time. Whilst we appreciate that Council had carried out consultation with the community and ratepayers over the use of Victoria Domain, that process missed out the most important group, the many hundreds of visitors who come from out of town. In New Year 2020 there were 220 car/trailer parking on the domain, New Year 2021 only 83 could be accommodated. We all know it was an absolute debacle. HOLIDAY DESTINATION During Xmas and New Year, the population of Picton increases from 5000 to an estimated 15,000. Picton Motels, Hotels, Apartments and Motor Camps coupled with Sounds properties and Resorts (many of which only have boat access). Almost all the local accommodation has no trailer parking facilities available. These visitors are imperative for the survival of the Business Community in Picton. "SHARE THE ROAD" We all see this sign on the Elevation when leaving Picton. We say for a short time 1 month at Xmas and New Year 4 days at Easter and 4 or 5 long weekends, SHARE THE PARK. ST JOHNS and RESCUE CENTRE We understand St Johns have requested a hardstand Heli Pad in front of the Rescue Centre for exclusive use (to accommodate two Helicopters). PBG fully supports this important facility. HEALTH and SAFETY. Speaking during a recent Regional Forum meeting a Senior Constable from the Picton Police commented on the extreme adverse effect of vehicles and trailers having to park on the roadside and also at times partly on the footpaths of adjoining streets. He stated that not only were the residents of surrounding streets unconvinced also it was a danger to cyclists and pedestrians. SOUNDS ACCESS FOR LOCALS There is No Free access for locals in either Picton or Waikawa they have to use and pay for launching at the Marinas. Waikawa Bay, whilst the fee is less it only has very limited parking. For this reason alone there must be always public parking at both marinas. AVAILABLE PARK SPACE FOR RECREATION AND DOGS Picton has the Skateboard park, Waitohi Domain both large areas and even with the proposed trailer there is still a significant area to run a dog and throw a ball.

Thank you for the opportunity to express our view on boat trailer parking in Picton and surrounding areas. Obviously there is more demand than ever for trailer parking in Picton and Waikawa. If a temporary parking increase extension plan is made available at peak times in Memorial Park then we support this option totally. During the busy holiday periods Waikawa Bay is jammed with boat trailers and vehicles taking up every available space. As a suggestion perhaps an option could be to use Beach Road reserve for temporary overflow parking during daylight hours and in a restricted area only. Another possible option could be to lease vacant land in Waikawa Road and made available for temporary parking at peak times. Our observations are that there is limited management enforcement of parking road rules with some vehicles and boat trailers left with wheels on and obstructing footpaths. Parking on maintained grass berms should not be allowed. Perhaps enforcement from Marlborough District Council Picton Parking wardens could also include Waikawa Bay.
