

## Public Notice of a proposed plan change to the Marlborough Sounds Resource Management Plan and a proposed plan variation to the Proposed Wairau/Awatere Resource Management Plan

In accordance with the First Schedule of the Resource Management Act 1991, the Marlborough District Council has prepared the following proposed plan change to the Marlborough Sounds Resource Management Plan (MSRMP) and proposed variation to the Proposed Wairau/Awatere Resource Management Plan (WARMP).

### Schedule of Changes

<b>Plan Change No. 14 MSRMP</b>	<p><u>Schedule J: State Integrated School</u></p> <p>This proposed plan change is to provide for <b>St Joseph's School</b> in the Plan where it is not currently provided for as a permitted activity, subject to standards contained in the Schedule.</p>
<b>Variation No. 48 WARMP</b>	<p><u>Schedule G: State Integrated School</u></p> <p>This proposed variation is to update and amend the permitted activities and standards applicable to Nelson Marlborough Institute of Technology, and provide for <b>St Mary's School</b> and <b>Richmond View School</b> in the Plan where they are not currently provided for as a permitted activity, subject to the respective standards contained in the Schedule.</p>

Any person who wishes to support or oppose any submission, by lodging a further submission, will be entitled to do so. The Council will then hold hearings to consider submissions that have been lodged and issue decisions on the matters raised. Anyone who has made a submission and who has indicated that they wish to be heard will have the right to attend the hearings and to present their submissions.

On receiving notice of a decision on their submission, any person may refer the decision to the Environment Court for further consideration if they are in disagreement with or are dissatisfied with the decision made by the Council.
