A time to remember

"They shall grow not old, as we that are left grow old: Age shall not weary them, nor the years condemn. At the going down of the sun and in the morning we will remember them."

As you pass Blenheim's Seymour Square in the lead up to Anzac Day, take a moment to remember those who have lost their lives in conflict.

The Returned Services Association (RSA) Marlborough branch coordinate this visual tribute with the Council's support. This

year Marlborough Boys' College students (pictured) helped place the crosses opposite Blenheim's war memorial. The 645 crosses are a poignant reminder of the region's loss, with each featuring the name and rank of a Marlborough soldier who lost their life.

Crosses have also been placed around the region at Canvastown, Grovetown, Havelock, Picton, Rai Valley, Renwick, Seddon, Spring Creek, Torea Bay, Wairau Valley and Ward.

Middle Renwick Road cycle lanes get green light

The project by Waka Kotahi NZ Transport Agency and the Council to extend on-road cycle lanes along Middle Renwick Road has got the green light following public consultation. Designed to increase cycling facilities and improve safety, the project will extend cycle lanes on Middle Renwick Road (State Highway 6) between Murphys Road/Battys Road roundabout and the Westwood Business Park. Public consultation was carried out last year, seeking feedback on the proposed design from residents, businesses and the wider community. Fifty five submissions were received. Key changes to the design resulting from public consultation include:

Adding two parking bays outside 157B and 163 Middle Renwick Road (which require the removal of a tree):

Widening the two parking bays outside 169 and 174 Middle

Renwick Road to 2.5 metres to accommodate trucks and larger vehicles; and

Adding a 1.5-metre-wide cycle path connection on Severne Street, connecting to the shared pathway.

A key objective was to retain as much parking as practical. Parking surveys of the area show low demand for parking so the provision should comfortably exceed the demand by over 40%. The construction will begin in early May 2021, with an estimated completion date of June 2021. Residents and businesses along the route will be updated by letter prior to construction. The project costs will be met 85% by Waka Kotahi NZ Transport Agency and 15% by Marlborough District Council.
