- **No Access – Road Closed**
 - Sections may be impassable for any vehicle
 - May have controlled pedestrian access for some sites

- **Controlled Access (Residents Only)**

- Permanent residents
- “Essential service provider” professional services with evidence of supporting welfare needs, emergency property repairs, insurance assessments
- The owner of a holiday home/bach or land
- Owner of a commercial interest
- Essential service supporting a commercial interest
- Emergency Services
- No heavy vehicle above 3.5T
- High risk of road closure
- May have restricted access at times
- Expect delays

- **Public Access (restricted)**

- HCV restriction
- May be closed due to weather or other event

- **Public Access**

- Possible speed restrictions
- Possible lane restrictions
- Expect road works
- Possible delays

- **Recovery Complete**

- Road returned to Marlborough Roads / NOC JV
