

Creative Communities NZ Local Arts Funding Approved 2013 -2014 Round 1

Funding has been made available for arts activities through a partnership agreement between Creative New Zealand and Council under criteria set by Creative New Zealand.

Creative Communities funding is allocated twice a year by the Grants Committee with closing dates at the end of February and September each year.

The total funds available to be allocated for the 2013/2014 financial year is \$33,507.
