

Waiving of Transfer Station Fees

Introduction

The waiving of Transfer Station Fees is an acknowledged way for Council to assist non profit organisations reduce costs when developing facilities or holding events for community, social, recreation, cultural and environmental benefit.

Policy

Council will waive transfer station fees for non profit organisations where the facility or activity is of community benefit and not for commercial gain.

Eligible organisations can receive assistance once per annum.

Criteria

- 1. Applicants must be a not for profit organisation.
- 2. The facility or activity must be of community benefit and not commercial gain.
- Full reimbursement of fees can be considered for one off activities (not annual or regular).
- 4. Reimbursement for ongoing users will be considered at a 50 % subsidy where the activity has a community waste reduction benefit.

How to Access

A request in writing to Council seeking a waiver of fees. This must include details of the organisation and the facility or activity the waiving of fees has been requested for.

Decision

Applications will be considered on a case by case basis by Council staff.

If it is not clear if the applicant or activity is eligible then the Manager, Assets and Services has delegated authority to make final decisions.
