

Motuweka / Havelock Pathway



Update: 18 August 2020

Over the first two weeks the team has:

- laid and compacted AP20 surface gravel over 320 metres of pathway beside the cemetery
- cleared vegetation from the pathway route below Brownlee Close and around the estuary edge to where the boardwalk will be constructed to link with the pathway below the cemetery
- benched the pathway from Brownlee Close to estuary edge
- laid base gravel along pathway
- surveyed and marked route of pathway along Foreshore Reserve in front of storage sheds to Wilson Street
- cleared in front of storage sheds
- cleared vegetation beside drain behind ITM off Inglis Street.

Photos attached show volunteers working, and the completed section near cemetery.

Starting on the 17 August they will begin to bench the pathway in front of the storage sheds.

Please remember this is a construction site and follow any health and safety instructions.
