



Over the first two weeks of September the team has

- Organised Outward Bound student volunteers to clear vegetation from the route behind Havelock ITM
- Benched the pathway off Inglis Street, below Havelock Quay. Created a 60 metre long rock wall beside the drain, laid base course gravel and compacted and installed culvert in drain leading off Lawrence Street
- Installed timber edging to pathway at marina entrance
- Felled two large pine trees posing a hazard at estuary edge off Wilson Street
- Placed further rock on estuary edge below cemetery
- Carted bridge and boardwalk timber to construction sites below Havelock Storage Sheds, and at Brownlee Close

Over the next few days they will complete work behind ITM and start constructing the pathway below Outram Street up to the skink fence.

They will then complete the land-based pathway work (other than the skink area) and then focus on the construction of the bridges and boardwalks.
