



## FINAL RESULT OF POLL

### Non-binding poll to decide on the proposal to establish a Business Improvement District in the Blenheim CBD from 1 July 2016

The voting period for the Blenheim CBD Business Improvement District poll closed at midday on Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup> November 2015.

**Proposal:**

*That a Business Improvement District be established in Blenheim CBD from 1 July 2016.*

The Business Improvement District policy requires the poll result to be calculated on both number/percentage of votes cast and a weighted basis, using the combined capital values of the properties where votes were cast.

The final result of the poll is:

	Number of Votes Cast/%	Weighted Percentage
Votes cast <b>FOR</b> the Proposal	111 / 47.04%	55.07%
Votes cast <b>AGAINST</b> the Proposal	124 / 52.54%	43.69%
Blank voting documents	1 / 0.42%	1.24%

The majority of votes cast in the poll voted **AGAINST** the proposal

The majority of weighted votes cast in the poll voted **FOR** the proposal.

The voting return percentage is 43.95% being 236 votes received, of which 39.83% voted online and 60.17% voted by post.
