



## How to read the data





## **Weekly Consumption**



Note: The above graph illustrates the water consumption in litres per week for each household with <u>three</u> people. The *trial property* reference number for each group refers to the consumption for a specific property, and is used for owners to identify their individual consumption over a seven day period.

When calculating your possible charges, 1000L (Litres) =  $1m^3$  (cubic metre).
