- First IWG hui 10 March 2010.
- Presented Iwi Chapter to Regional Planning and Development Committee on 11 June 2014.
- Last IWG hui prior to presentation was 10 December 2013.
- An additional IWG hui was held on 12 August 2015 to discuss the water allocation and use draft provisions.

(ii) Whether the OTS plans as to statutory areas of interest referred to in Schedule One of each of the Te Tau Ihu Settlement Acts are publically and freely available for search.
