The Association made a submission and further submissions about the subject matter of the Proceedings. The Association also represents the interests of residents and communities within the central parts of the Marlborough Sounds and has an interest greater than the public generally in the issues raised in the appeals.

The Association is not a trade competitor for the purposes of section 308C or 308CA of the Resource Management Act 1991.

The Association is interested in all of the Proceedings.

The Appellant's are disputing the decision of the Council in respect of certain of the MEP Topics and the Association is interested in all the issues raised by the appeal Proceedings.

In particular, the Association is interested in the general issues raised by the Appellants in regard to Natural Character, Landscape and Indigenous biodiversity to the extent they are in opposition to the relief sought by the appeal and proceedings set out in *Friends of Nelson Haven and Tasman Bay Inc v Marlborough District Council ENC- 2020-CHC- 033*; and those parts of each of the Proceedings seeking specific changes to Natural Character and Landscape, MEP mapped ratings for identified areas or identified marine farms as set out in Schedule A of an appellants appeal; and specific changes to the MEP's proposals as to the identification of Ecologically Significant Marine Areas and associated buffer zones as set out in Schedule A of an appellants appeal.

The Association opposes the relief sought because it will not achieve the objectives and policies of the New Zealand Coastal Policy Statement and thereby not support and encourage sustainable management of the Coastal Environment.

The Association agrees to participate in mediation or other alternative dispute resolution of the Proceedings.
