- This memorandum is filed in response to the Council's memorandum of 31 July 2020 and in accordance with the Court's minute dated 16 June 2020.
- This appeal will likely be affected by the incoming National Environmental Standards for Freshwater and National Policy Statement for Freshwater Management. The Ministry for the Environment has published statements that these national direction documents are likely to be gazetted towards the end of this year.
