MAY IT PLEASE THE COURT:

- 1. This memorandum is filed in response to the Council's case management memorandum of 31 July 2020 and in accordance with the Court's minute dated 16 June 2020.
- 2. The Council suggests that there may be merit in the Court placing the Indigenous Biodiversity topic (in so far as the national policy statement relates to the Council's Significant Natural Areas Programme and indigenous vegetation clearance rules) in a "temporary hiatus" until such time as the Council and parties have the opportunity to consider the content of the National Policy Statement for Indigenous Biodiversity (NPS-IB).
- 3. The following parties ("Parties") have an interest in the Indigenous Biodiversity topic by virtue of their appeals/section 274 notices:
 - 3.1. Minister of Conservation; and
 - 3.2. Royal Forest and Bird Protection Society of NZ Incorporated.
- 4. The Parties submit that the Court should not place any part of the Indigenous Biodiversity topic in a hiatus on the basis that the gazettal date of the NPS-IB is not known with any certainty (or guaranteed).
