- 1 I refer to the Court's Minute of 26 February 2020.
- I wish to clarify on whom service of a Notice of Appeal needs to be effected.My understanding of the Court's Directions is:
 - (a) Where the appellant is an (original) submitter pursuant to Schedule 1,
 Clause 6, the Notice of Appeal needs to be served on all people who
 made further submissions (Schedule 1, Clause 8) on that original
 submission on the provision under appeal;
 - (b) Where the appellant is a further submitter, the appellant must serve the person who made the corresponding submission under Clause 6.

But:

- (c) Service is not required on other people who made a submission on the provision or matter to which the appeal relates;
- (d) Where the appellant is a further submitter, the appellant need not serve other further submitters on that original submission.
- 3 This appears to be the consequence of the Directions in paragraph [7(2)] as well as the consequence of the order in *Re Auckland Council* [2016] NZEnvC 153 at [17(a)].
