- 1. At the hearing of Topic 5: Natural Character and Landscape, Mr James Bentley, in his reply to evidence provided at the hearing, indicated that, if the Panel wished, a desk top assessment could be completed providing a detailed recommendation as to the rating of Natural Character in respect of the following two locations:
  - (i) The head of Port Gore surrounding the Marchant property.
  - (ii) The northern Crail Bay ridge area separating Crail Bay from the main Pelorus Sound in the vicinity of the Hemphill property.
- 2. This offer was made in response to evidence challenging the accuracy of the assessments at those locations as recorded in Volumes 3 and 4.
- Once received, Mr Bentley's assessments will form part of his public section 42A response to the evidence.
