Minute of the Hearing Panel

Minute 23

1. In the course of deliberations on the Urban Environments Topic in the Marlborough Environment Plan (MEP), the Panel has formed the view that New Zealand Transport Agency's (NZTA) request for relief as to provisions applying in respect of subdivisions with indirect linkages with State Highways requires more information to be provided by NZTA.
2. The information sought by the Panel is a map which clearly identifies which side roads within the area covered by the MEP, and the extent of them, which NZTA asserts may potentially have an adverse effect on the operation of the State Highway network.
3. The Hearing Panel requests that map be provided as soon as reasonably possible, but no later than 31 July, 2018.
