Minute 24

1. In the course of deliberations on the issue of special subdivision provisions for boundary adjustments, the Hearing Panel noted that the section 42A report only recommended such provisions for the Rural Environment zone.
2. The recommendation was made that such provisions not apply in other zones because that *“would be at odds to the Objectives and Policies that want to avoid residential development in those areas.”*
3. The Panel requests that you identify the policies and objectives in the Coastal Living and Rural Living zones upon which you formed that view.
