Minute of the Hearing Panel

Minute 28

1. On Monday, 28 May, 2018, in the course of the hearing of the presentation by the New Zealand Transport Agency (NZTA), a request was made by NZTA that an opportunity be provided for NZTA and a representative of Marlborough Roads to engage in some discussions to provide advice on technical terms used in the standards in rule 2.32.4 of the Marlborough Environment Plan (MEP) so as to achieve a level of consistency.
2. Those issues of technical language terms were raised in paragraphs 57 to 59 of the evidence of Kate Searle.
3. The Hearing Panel agreed to that request and the purpose of this Minute is to fix a date for the outcome of those discussions to be reported back to the Panel, with that date being fixed as being Friday 29 June, 2018.
4. The Hearing Panel also wishes to stress that the purpose of those discussions is not to debate the merits of the MEP provisions but solely to seek to revise the technical terminology to be used in the standards
