

## **Proposed Marlborough Environment Plan**

### **Minute of the Hearing Panel**

#### **Minute 3AL**

On 27 February 2018, the Proposed Marlborough Environment Plan Hearing Panel (the Panel) received a request from Heritage New Zealand Pouhere Taonga who sought additional time to present on Topic 8: Heritage and Notable Trees.

Heritage New Zealand Pouhere Taonga requested a further 20 minutes be added to their appearance time as several persons would be presenting on their behalf. Evidence had been uploaded to the Hearing Portal reflecting this. Heritage New Zealand Pouhere Taonga further noted that the Heritage Resources and Notable Trees topic was a significant one for them and their evidence would need to address several specific heritage sites.

The Panel considered the request to be reasonable and granted the additional time. Heritage New Zealand Pouhere Taonga would be provided a 40 minute time slot to present to the Panel during the hearing for Heritage Resources and Notable Trees.
