Minute of the Hearing Panel

Minute 3AR

On 23 March 2018, the Proposed Marlborough Environment Plan Hearing Panel (the Panel) received a request on behalf of counsel for KiwiRail Holdings Limited (KiwiRail).

The request was for an extension to the date for filing evidence, specifically that it now fall due on Wednesday 28 March 2018. The reason provided for the request was the unavailability of the submitter's witness, which meant they were unable to finalise the evidence. KiwiRail also requested further time (45 minutes) to present as there would be several people attending the Panel on KiwiRail's behalf.

The Panel considered the request for an extension to filing was reasonable and confirmed KiwiRail's evidence would be required by 28 March 2018. In regards to the extension to presentation time, the Panel agreed that further time would be required for KiwiRail to present given the matters that would be addressed at the hearing of the Coastal Envrionments topic and granted a further 20 minutes, being 40 minutes in full, not including questions from the Panel.
