

## **Proposed Marlborough Environment Plan**

### **Minute of the Hearing Panel**

#### **Minute 3AZ**

On 25 June 2018, the Proposed Marlborough Environment Plan Hearing Panel (the Panel) received a request from Simcox Construction Limited (Simcox) for extra time to present at the hearing on Topic 12: Rural Environments.

Simcox requested a further 20 minutes to be heard at the Block 7 hearing on the basis that the evidence of Simcox, on quarrying in the region, was extensive and they would need adequate time to address the issues being raised. It was further noted that there would be four experts appearing on behalf of Simcox at the hearing. Briefs of evidence for all experts had been provided.

The Panel considered the evidence provided by Simcox and agreed that more time may be required to allow all experts to briefly address the matters being raised by the submitter. Therefore, a second timeslot of 20 minutes, not including questions from the panel, would be provided at the hearing of Topic 12: Rural Environments.
