Minute of the Hearing Panel

On 6 November 2017, the Proposed Marlborough Environment Plan Hearing Panel (the Panel) received a request from Te Runanga O Kaikoura and Te Runanga o Ngai Tahu (TRONT) for additional time and to be heard out of sequence. The Panel's First and Second Minutes set the deadline at 6 November 2017.

TRONT have requested to address their submissions on Topic 2: Marlborough's Tangata Whenua Iwi and Topic 3: Natural and Physical Resources during the first week of hearing. TRONT explained that presenting the two topics at the same time would allow for a more cohesive presentation due to the interrelationship in the issues these topics raised. In order to adequately address the issues, TRONT further requested a 45 minute time slot.

The Panel considered the above requests could assist the Panel in its task of ensuring the MEP integrates the management of natural and physical resources with Chapter 3 matters.

The Panel therefore grants the requests to be heard out of sequence and for an additional 25 minutes to present.
