On 7 December 2017, the Proposed Marlborough Environment Plan Hearing Panel (the Panel) received a request from Murray Chapman to be heard on the entirety of his submission at one hearing topic.

Mr Chapman explained he was unavailable to attend the Block 2 hearing dates due to previous commitments. He also noted that the matters raised in his submission were narrow in focus and would lend themselves to being heard during the Rural Environment topic which has been tentatively set down for July.

The Panel were of the view that Mr Chapman's request was reasonable and his submission could be suitably dealt with at one appearance, as suggested. Therefore the panel granted the request for Mr Chapman to be heard on his submission in its entirety, during the Rural Environment topic.
