Minute of the Hearing Panel

On 11 December 2017, the Proposed Marlborough Environment Plan Hearing Panel (the Panel) received a request from Te Runanga o Kaikōura and Te Runanga o Ngāi Tahu (Ngāi Tahu) for an extension of time to present at the hearing on Topic 5: Natural Character and Landscape and separately on Topic 6: Indigenous Biodiversity. Ngāi Tahu sought a 30 minute time slot, exclusive of question time from the Panel, for each of the above topics.

Ngāi Tahu requested the additional 10 minutes in order to adequately address submissions on both topics.

The Panel considered the request reasonable and granted a 30 minute time slot during Topic 5: Natural Character and Landscape and Topic 6: Indigenous Biodiversity hearing weeks.
