Minute of the Hearing Panel

Minute 3BE

On 17 September 2018, the Proposed Marlborough Environment Plan Hearing Panel (the Panel) received a request from Counsel for the Rarangi District Residents Association (the Association) seeking to be heard Waste and Discharges to Land matters during the hearing of the Resource Quality – Water topic.

The Association sought leave to speak to its submission points pertaining to soil sensitive matters (which formed part of the Waste and Discharges to Land topic) at the same time as addressing its submission points on Water Quality. The Association requested the bundling of the submission points due to the subject matter being heavily interrelated.

The Panel agreed that no issue would arise from these submission points being presented at the one appearance. The Panel granted the request for the Association to be heard on Topic 14: Waste and Discharges to Land and Topic 13: Resource Quality – Water during one timeslot within the Block 9 hearing.
