This analysis supports the proposed rezoning, and forms part of the section 32 RMA information. No comprehensive assessment of effects. The plan change includes an AEE commensurate with the Resource Management Act requirements which was accepted by Council. Lack of certainty. Reverse sensitivity is adequately addressed. Lack of certainty. There is no statutory obligation to provide any conceptual or detailed survey plan, staging plan or other matters set out in the submission, and Colonial Vineyards disagree there is lack of certainty. However, if this concern is found to be valid, Colonial Vineyard would not be averse to an amendment to the plan change to require a structure plan to be provided at the time of subdivision. This could be incorporated by a new rule (to give effect to submission 31) requiring a structure plan to be provided for the whole development (as a controlled activity) to accompany the first application for any subdivision. Matters of control would revolve around urban design aspects and more prescription in terms of the internal layout for services. Such a structure plan would be incorporated as part of the subdivision consent process las a controlled activity) to identify services and infrastructure to achieve 	Reject. Submission - Plan change 59 - Colonial Vireyards

The application relies heavily on the Urban Development Plan produced for the Council to assist in identifying areas of POTENTIAL expansion of residential property.

I do not agree with the roading assessment, once again the applicants assessment relies on the Urban Development Plan, which has not thoroughly been investigated.

The impact this plan change and future development will have on the surrounding road network. I would imagine a roundabout upgrade to the Battys Rd / Richardson Ave / New Renwick Rd would be required and this would probably require the purchase of the surrounding privately owned properties to this intersection. There would likely be an upgrade to the Aerodrome Rd intersection also. The requirements of the roading upgrades should be determined through a thorough roading assessment (not provided).

The creation of smaller lots is not in keeping with the rural aspect of this area. Surrounding properties immediately north and east of the proposed rezoning are 800-1000m2 in parcel area. Other areas west and south are much larger. My main objection is to the proposed Urban residential zone 1 and would prefer if a minimum lot area of 800m2 is adopted.

The proximity to Airfield is a concern. The airfield is a strategic asset for Marlborough. I would like to see a restriction on the plan change to only extend south as far as the end of the Richardson Ave residential development (approx 260m south of New Renwick Rd) the remaining land would enable a buffer to the airfield and could be developed into a park for the development (rather than parks within the proposed properties).
