The planning rules in city and district resource management plans governing the installation of amateur radio antennas, aerials, and their supporting structures are a confused mess.

They range from reasonably accommodating permitted use rules, to highly restrictive discretionary use rules requiring consents for even the most modest of installations.

More importantly, the rules are becoming increasingly restrictive throughout the country, and these egregious controls and the costs they impose on amateur radio operators are restricting participation and entry into the avocation of amateur radio.

The amateur radio services are authorised by the conventions of the International Telecommunications Union (ITU). There are two separate services as defined in the following extract from the ITU Radio Regulations:

1.56 amateur service: A radiocommunication service for the purpose of self training, intercommunication and technical investigations carried out by amateurs, that is, by duly authorized persons interested in radio technique solely with a personal aim and without pecuniary interest.

1.57 amateur-satellite service: A radiocommunication service using space stations on earth satellites for the same purposes as those of the amateur service.

New Zealand is a signatory to the ITU conventions and amateur radio is administered in New Zealand by the Radio Spectrum Management unit of MBIE. Entry requires proof of technical competence by examination. Once upon a time, an aspiring radio amateur would build or buy his own station equipment, and hoist a wire aerial attached to a pole or suitable tree. The simple wire is generally very limiting these days, due to the rise in the noise floor – the ever-present radio noise that emanates from the proliferation of electrical and electronic equipment that supports our lifestyle. This noise can only be overcome with aerials and antennas which have heights which raise them above the surrounding buildings and for the frequencies above 10 MHz, usually by arrays of metal tubes, such as with an analogue television aerial, to provide signal gain.

To achieve the necessary height and dimension of antenna is becoming a huge hurdle for the amateur radio operator who wishes to participate in long distance amateur radio communication. The present planning rules in many cases require the outlay of daunting sums (compared to the equipment costs) in seeking resource consents, with no guarantee of any certainty that consent would be granted. Planners who recommend rules and councillors who approve them frequently have no basic knowledge of the requirements of radio communication. Rules are imposed not because they must be but because they can be, to the considerable detriment of the amateur radio services.

There are around three million amateur radio operators worldwide, and more than 5000 in New Zealand, although not all are currently active. Generally their antenna and mast requirements are modest.

Radio amateurs who discovered the usefulness of short waves, after commercial interests discarded those waves as being of no value, pioneered long-distance and worldwide radio communications. Amateurs, who wish to participate in international long-distance communications, where signal strengths are generally low, face huge bills in gaining resource consents.

We have no quibble about building consent costs, which are a necessary part of safety compliance costs, but find that requirements for resource consent, are often imposed by arbitrary and capricious rules. Many councils make direct comparisons with the network utility providers and other utilities, and impose rules which are appropriate for the utility operators, but which deny reasonable amateur antenna configurations as permitted uses. These comparisons have no validity in respect of long-distance (DX) communication. DX is difficult from New Zealand, as most of the world's population is on the other side of the world from New Zealand.

In 1985 the United States federal government became increasingly concerned about the negative effect that unduly restrictive state and local planning ordinances were having on the amateur radio service, and mandated by federal order, known as PRB-1, that local authorities must provide a reasonable accommodation for amateur radio antenna installations. PRB-1 pre-empts state and local planning law. It is a great pity that such a pre-emption does not exist in New Zealand.

An Environment Court judge in an appeal at Tauranga recently ordered that Tauranga City Council include in that city's proposed district plan amateur radio antenna masts up to 20 metres in height as permitted uses. Another Environment Court judge even more recently declined an appeal in Wellington seeking 18 metre height as a permitted use, leaving the permitted use heights at 8 and 10 metres. That same judge several years ago approved a consent order in an appeal against North Shore City Council, approving 15 metres as a permitted amateur radio mast height. We should be able to expect greater uniformity in judicial decisions. The requirements of amateur radio operator who seek to participate in long distance radio communications are the same regardless of where in New Zealand they operate. Likewise, the effects of such masts are the same around New Zealand, although this is hardly evidenced by the huge variations in planning rules around New Zealand.

The costs of defending appeals against Council decisions can be ill afforded, particularly by the smaller rural districts councils.

These comments are provided to

- demonstrate how the avocation of amateur radio is being unfairly treated under the RMA,
- suggest that a national guideline be developed to ensure that that amateur radio service is reasonably accommodated within the various district plans,
- suggest that there be uniformity of regulation throughout New Zealand,
- oppose the excessive costs of the present RMA consent process for obtaining consents for effective amateur radio antenna installations.
