#### **Purpose**

1. The purpose of this report is to present background for the remuneration of Councillors to enable Council to formulate a proposal to the Remuneration Authority for the remuneration of Councillors for the period from the publication of official results of the 2022 Triennial Election to 30 June 2023.

#### RECOMMENDED

That Council present to the Remuneration Authority its proposal for the remuneration of Councillors by Wednesday 16 November 2022.

#### Background

- 2. The Remuneration Authority (Authority) have kept the "pool" approach for Councillors' remuneration post the 2022 Triennial Election.
- 3. The Authority determined that the Incoming Council will decide on the distribution of the "pool" after the election.
- 4. The Authority will still directly set the Mayor's remuneration this does not affect the "pool".
- 5. Since 2019 the Authority has used a group of size indices (e.g., for Unitary Authorities the Authority use population, total operating expenditure, total assets, socioeconomic deprivation index, geographic size, and public transport boardings) to set the "pool".
- 6. The relevant workload and responsibilities of each Council are weighted, and each Council is placed in order within the relevant index.

#### Pool

- 7. The Authority have set the "pool" by determination for the post Triennial Election period through to 30 June 2023 at \$609,333.
- 8. For comparison, the "pool" prior to the 2022 Triennial Election was \$597,552.

#### **Minimum Remuneration**

9. The Authority has determined that the minimum remuneration for a Councillor (with no added responsibility) will be \$38,306.

#### **Conditions**

- 10. The Authority have determined that the entire "pool" MUST be allocated; and that the base remuneration for a Councillor MUST NOT be set below the prescribed Councillor minimum allowable remuneration rate.
- 11. The Authority have also determined that the "pool" does NOT apply to appointed members and their remuneration cannot be legally prescribed by the Authority.

#### **Options**

12. Staff will present to the meeting information to enable Council to form its proposal to the Remuneration Authority.
