Commissioner Crosby confirmed he would not deliberate on matters relating to those locations.

The challenge was based on Council's involvement in and ownership of Port Marlborough Limited and, in respect of Cllr Hook in particular, based on statements made by him in 2012/2013 on the effect on Picton of the potential relocation of the ferry terminal to Clifford Bay.  The Panel considered the challenge and concluded that the reasoning for the Councillors to step down was insufficient. All Panel members remained.
